The following is taken directly from the Science Society constitution to explain the role.

Article 4. Functions and Duties

Section 1. Executive

4.1.6. Vice President of Student Advocacy

- 4.1.6.1. Shall train and direct the following Officers with their respective responsibilities according to this constitution and assume the respective obligations if the position is vacated during the academic year:
 - Academic Officer
 - Awards & Appointments Officer
 - Volunteer Officer
- 4.1.6.2. Shall be responsible for communicating with all University related student mental health groups and communicating all relevant information to the student body.
- 4.1.6.3. Shall be responsible for organizing and executing at least two Wellness Wednesday events per semester.
- 4.1.6.4. Shall lobby the faculty with student's academic concerns.
- 4.1.6.5. Shall hold a minimum of two office hours per week for the Fall & Winter Semesters.
- 4.1.6.6. Any other responsibilities necessitated by council.
