The following is taken directly from the Science Society constitution to explain the roles and number of positions available.

Article 2. Council Structure

2.1.2. Representative Positions

2.1.2.1. The number of department representatives will be determined based on the following:

- a) 1-150 students in department: 1 representative
- b) 151-300 students in department: 2 representatives
- c) 301-450 students in department: 3 representatives
- d) 451-600 students in department: 4 representatives

2.1.2.2. The elected representative officers and voting members of the University of Windsor Science Society Council shall be as follows:

- a) Five 1st Year Representatives
- b) Three 2nd Year Representatives
- c) Sixteen Departmental Representatives, as per the following:
 - i. 1 x Behaviour and Cognitive Neuroscience
 - ii. 3 x Biological Sciences
 - iii. 2 x Health and Biomedical Stream
 - iv. 1 x Biochemistry
 - v. 1 x Chemistry
 - vi. 1 x Economics
 - vii. 1 x Environmental Studies or Science
 - viii. 2 x Forensics
 - ix. 1 x General Science
 - x. 1 x Mathematics and Statistics
 - xi. 1 x Physics
 - xii. 1 x Arts and Sciences

2.1.2.3 If the number of students enrolled in a department is within 5% of the upper bounds of the lower tier, then the lower tier will be used in deciding how many reps will be given a position in the winter election. In the following fall semester, if the enrollment places the department in a

Article 4. Functions and Duties

Section 3. Year Representatives

- 4.3.1. Shall be a liaison between their respective year and Science Society.
- 4.3.2. Shall communicate all Society approved events to their constituents.
- 4.3.3. Shall publicize all major Science Society events to constituents through class talks.
- 4.3.4. Shall make every attempt to attend all Science Society events.
- 4.3.5. Shall report all concerns and questions during the Council meeting.
- 4.3.6. Shall hold a minimum of one office hour per week during the Fall & Winter semesters.
- 4.3.7. Shall carry out any other duties assigned by the executive members pertaining to Science Society matters.

Section 4. Departmental Representatives

- 4.4.1. Shall act as a liaison between Science Society and the respective club of their department.
- 4.4.2. Shall make every attempt to attend the respective club of their department's meetings and update council on relevant matters that pertain to the council.
- 4.4.3. Can invite members from the clubs or societies to Science Society meetings.
- 4.4.4. Shall publicize all major events with their respective programs.
- 4.4.5. Shall organize and execute Science Society Frosh Week Events, at the discretion of the Vice President Internal and President.
- 4.4.6. Shall assist the Academic Officer in the execution of the annual Meet the Prof event and shall promote the event to the faculty and students of their respective departments.
- 4.3.7. Shall make every attempt to attend all Science Society events.
- 4.3.8. Shall report all concerns and questions during the Council meeting.
- 4.4.9. Shall hold a minimum of one office hour per week during the Fall & Winter semesters.
- 4.4.10. Shall carry out any other duties assigned by the executive members pertaining to Science Society matters.
